### call for pecha kucha

The biennale svizzera del territorio 2024, organised by the <u>Istituto Internazionale</u> <u>di Architettura in Lugano</u>, is launching a call for pecha kucha on the theme "back to the future". The call is open to everyone, students and professionals of all ages and from all over the world.

#### back to the future

The future has been cancelled. Imagination, exhausted by successive crises, constant innovation, and immediate returns on investment, comes up against a closed horizon. Drunk with nostalgia, it has dismissed any long-term vision as utopian, a mere fantasy – until we face dystopia. Yet the prior task of architecture has always been concerned with the future: we still live structures built decades, even centuries ago. Where did we get lost? The 5th edition of the biennale svizzera del territorio is a call on imagination. A call to reclaim the future and project together alternatives to the slow unfolding of the present.

#### formato

Contributions can be research, photographs, collages, texts, videos, realised or theoretical projects, as long as they are related to the theme of the call. The selected contributions will be presented during the biennial in a session, which will host the contribution of ten participants. Participants will only be allowed to present one pecha kucha per session. As part of the pecha kucha format (www.pechakucha.org), presentations should have a maximum duration of 6 minutes and 40 seconds. Each presentation should be accompanied by 20 slides projected for 20 seconds each.
